Professor Kim graduated from Seoul National University College of Medicine in 1981 and received his cardiothoracic surgical training at Seoul National University Hospital, Korea between 1982 and 1986. Between 1992 and 1994, he was a Research Scholar at Washington University in St. Louis, USA, under Professor James Cox. He is Professor Emeritus of Seoul National University Hospital, and currently Director of Cardiovascular Center, Myong-ji Hospital, Gyeong-gi do, Rep. of KOREA.

Professor Kim is the member of 9 professional societies including the American Association for Thoracic Surgery and the Society of Thoracic Surgeons. Professor Kim played leadership roles at several Korean cardiovascular specialty committees and executed the President of the 50th annual meeting of the Korean Society for Thoracic and Cardiovascular Surgery, 2018. He has contributed to more than 250 original articles in peer-reviewed journals and is a frequently invited speaker at regional or international conferences.

Professor Kim's major research and clinical interests are myocardial ischemia-protection, CABG surgery and off-pump CABG, surgery for ischemic LV dysfunction, and atrial fibrillation and Maze procedure.
