

Dr Vipin Zamvar is a Consultant Cardiothoracic Surgeon at the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh, UK

He has a joint cardiac and thoracic surgical practice, and his main areas of interests are Coronary Artery Bypass Graft Surgery, Off-Pump Surgery, Minimally Invasive Cardiac and Thoracic Surgery, Aortic Valve Surgery, TAVI, and VATS.

His main research interests are in the field of Coronary Artery Bypass Graft Surgery. He is the primary investigator of many multi-centre trials exploring the issues of conduits and techniques used in Coronary Artery Surgery.

He was the President of the World Society of Cardiothoracic Surgeons (2015-16) and is now the Secretary-General. He has been the Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Cardiothoracic Surgery* since 2006.

In 2017, he delivered the WSCTS Eponymous lecture, and described the "Zamvar Pericardial Fold".

Outside Surgery, his interests include Chess, and his FIDE rating is about 1600.
